School Rules

The uniform list above outlines what pupils are expected to wear throughout the school day.

Overcoats/Jackets

All pupils should wear an appropriate coat or jacket to protect against cold and wet weather.

Jewellery

In the interests of health and safety, pupils are not allowed to wear jewellery other than a watch and one pair of stud earrings; jewellery associated with body piercing, other than ear lobes, is strictly prohibited. Jewellery, including sleepers and studs, must be removed for PE even though it can be worn at other times.

Hair

Students who have long hair must tie it back during activities where personal safety requires this.

Personal Belongings

All personal belongings should be clearly marked with the owner's name. Any money should be handed into the class tutor or the school office for safekeeping.

Valuable items such mobile phones, MP3s and similar items **MUST BE HANDED IN TO THE CLASS TUTOR ON ARRIVAL IN THE MORNING AND WILL BE STORED IN A SAFE PLACE**. Parents should note that the school cannot accept liability for the loss or damage of personal property. Anything found should be handed into a member of staff or the school office.
